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We also have a colour coded lanyard system so that staff, visitors, students over 18 and students under 18 can be identified at the blink of an eye.

HOW DO I GET A VISA LETTER FROM THE COLLEGE?

First, make sure you get an offer letter from the admissions department, please see 'how to apply' for more information.

Once your payment has been processed (this usually takes 2-3 working days), the admissions department will send you the visa letter within 24 hours.

If you are studying for less than 12 weeks or studying at NCG Dublin for any length, you have to pay your full fees to get a Visa letter from the school.

If you are studying for 12 weeks or more at NCG Manchester or Liverpool, you can pay a 50% deposit of your total fees to get a Visa letter from the school.

If your Visa application is unsuccessful you will be fully refunded except for a £200 admin fee. Terms and Conditions apply.

CAN I SET UP A BANK ACCOUNT?

If you want to set up a bank account whilst you are studying in the UK or Ireland, you'll have to do this yourself. NCG can give you a letter to give to the bank to prove you are studying here. NCG can't tell you which bank to choose, you'll have to do your own research and compare accounts.
